Taiwan has a very **fast** train. It is called the High Speed Rail, or HSR. The trains are white and orange. They look very **modern** and clean. Many people ride them every day.



The HSR can go 300 kilometers per hour. That is very **speedy**! A trip from Taipei to Kaohsiung takes only 90 **minutes**. By car, the same trip takes about 4 hours.

The HSR started in 2007. It has 12 **stations** along the west side of Taiwan. The trains are very **comfortable**. They have big seats and air conditioning. You can even buy food on the train.

Riding the HSR is easy. You can buy **tickets** at the station or online. There are machines that speak English too. Many **tourists** use the HSR to travel around Taiwan.

The trains are also very **safe**. They stop **automatically** if there is a problem. Taiwan is proud of its high speed rail. It helps people travel quickly and easily!
