At home, AI can help **control** many things. Smart speakers can play music, answer questions, or turn off the lights. Smart **thermostats** learn what temperature you like and **adjust** the heating or cooling on their own. AI even helps some people remember to take their medicine.

AI also plays a big role in **entertainment**. Streaming apps use AI to figure out what movies or songs you enjoy. Gaming apps use AI to **challenge** players at the right level — not too easy, not too hard. AI can even help **create** music, art, and stories.

Living with AI means making **choices** about how much we use it. Some people worry that we might **depend** on AI too much and forget how to do things ourselves. It is important to use AI as a **tool** — something that helps us — rather than letting it make all our decisions for us.



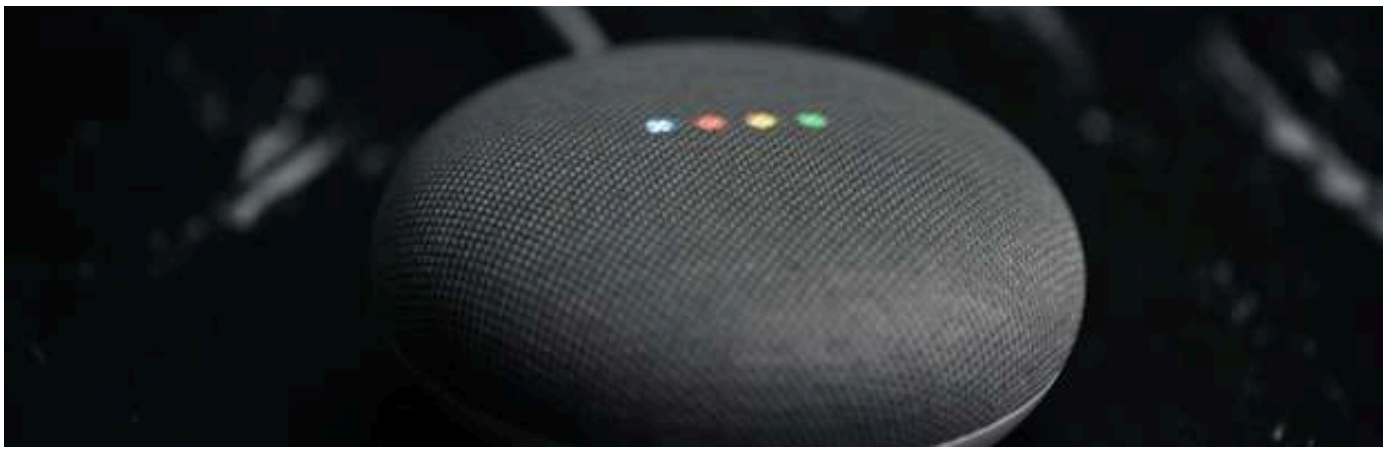
