



Penguins — Funny Birds of the Cold

A penguin is a special **bird** that cannot **fly**.

It has small wings, but it uses them to swim, not to fly in the sky. A penguin's body is **black** on the back and white on the front. It walks on two short legs and has a long **tail** to help it balance. Penguins look very funny when they walk on **land**!

Most penguins live in very **cold** places. Many live near the **ice** and **snow** at the bottom of the world. They love the sea. A penguin can swim very fast and stay underwater for many minutes. Its little wings help it move through the water like a fish.

Penguins love to **eat fish**. They jump into the cold **sea** to **catch** many small fish each day. They also eat tiny animals called krill. A hungry penguin can eat a lot of food! It needs this food to keep its body warm in the cold.

Mother and father penguins take very good care of their babies. The mother lays one **egg**. Then the father keeps the egg warm on his feet. After about two months, a small baby penguin comes out. The baby is soft and gray, not black and white like its parents.

Penguins live together in big groups called colonies. Thousands of penguins can live in one place! They keep each other warm and safe. So next time you see a penguin, smile and remember — this funny bird is one of the best swimmers in the world.
